

MICROFIBRE CLEANING KIT

General

Regularly vacuum the fabric with soft brush nozzle attachment.

Surface dirt and light soiling

Wet the white microfibre cloth in hot water, add a few squirts of Microfibre Cleaner and wring out hard. Fold the cloth, and then wrap the cloth around the blue sponge, to make a hard roll (like a sausage roll!) Pull the roll backwards and forwards over the soiled areas to "lift" the dirt on to the cloth. Let fabric dry and then brush the fibres with the white polyester sponge.



Heavier soiling

Vacuum the microfibre fabric with soft brush nozzle attachment.

Squeeze out a foam on the blue sponge and clean with the foam using light circulating movements on a limited area at a time, e.g. within stitching. Repeat on other parts until all the areas are cleaned.

Damp the microfibre cloth with clean water and clean the foam leftovers.

Let dry and then brush the fibres with the white polyester sponge.

Stains

- Always pre-test to make sure that the fabric is not affected with the liquids used.
- Remove the stain while it is still fresh.
- Work from the outside and in towards the centre of the stain.
- Leave the outer circle damp to avoid ring marks after the stain liquids.
- If possible, place an absorbing paper/fabric on the back of the stained area of the microfibre and frequently change it.
- Never let solvents penetrate the fabric, as it can easily make foam interiors swell.
